

# Drop Everything and Read (DEAR) Activity

## Classes I to V

### Learning Objectives:

To enable the learners to:

- Analyze characters, themes, and plot development in literary texts.
- Compare and contrast ideas, characters, or events within or between texts.
- Identify bias, assumptions, or logical fallacies in informational text.

### Description of the activity

**DEAR (Drop Everything and Read)** is a silent, independent reading activity where students stopped all other tasks and spent a set amount of time reading a book of their choice. The goal was to foster a love for reading, improve reading fluency, and build lifelong reading habits. It encouraged self-selected reading in a relaxed environment, promoting engagement and enjoyment without the pressure of assessments or assignments.

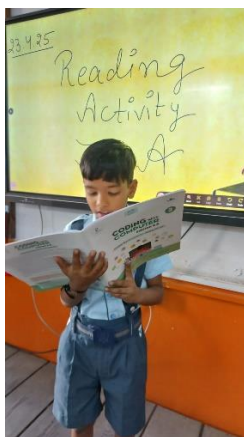
