
Make a roller chart on Land transport – (Trains) showing different types of trains from 1900 – 2024. Also show how these means of transport affected climate change over the period of time.

Make a Solar Cooker.



STEPS TO PREPARE THE MODEL:

1. Materials: A Cardboard Box, Aluminium Foil, Glass or Plastic Cover, Glue, Black paint, and a reflective material like foil or mirror.

- 2. Construct the Box: Cut a flap in the top of the box and cover it with plastic or glass to create a window. This will allow sunlight to enter.
- 3. Line with Reflective Material: Line the inside of the box with aluminium foil or reflective material to maximize sunlight absorption.
- 4. Paint the Interior Black: Paint the bottom and sides of the box black to help absorb heat.
- 5. Make a Reflective Lid: Create a lid using aluminium foil or reflective material to reflect sunlight into the box.
- 6. Assemble: Assemble the cooker, making sure all components fit securely and cooker is stable.
- 7. Test: Test your Cooker on a sunny day to ensure it reaches high temperatures. Adjust as needed.
- 8. Cooking: Once it's ready, you can use your Solar Cooker to bake, boil or steam food by placing it inside the box.
