

## Students of Tula's International School, Uttarakhand perform supremely well in CBSE board exams



The students of Tula's International School, Dehradun, Uttarakhand, have come out with flying colours during the CBSE board exams. Archita Agarwal is the Class 10 Topper with 98.6%, followed by Akshat Maitreya who secured 96.4%. The third topper is Aasya Joshi who secured 95.2%. The average percentage of Tula's International School for class 10 is 85% with 36% students securing marks between 90-100% and 42% students scoring between 80-90%.

Tula's International School has also recorded a remarkable achievement with its Class 12 students securing excellent scores in the board exams. Sanjeevani Arya from the science stream secured the 1st rank with 99%. This was followed by Nipun K Kushwaha, securing 98.4% and Akshit Mittal bagging the third rank with 97.2%.
