The museum's engaging displays, interactive panels, digital exhibits, and rare photographs captured the attention of the students.

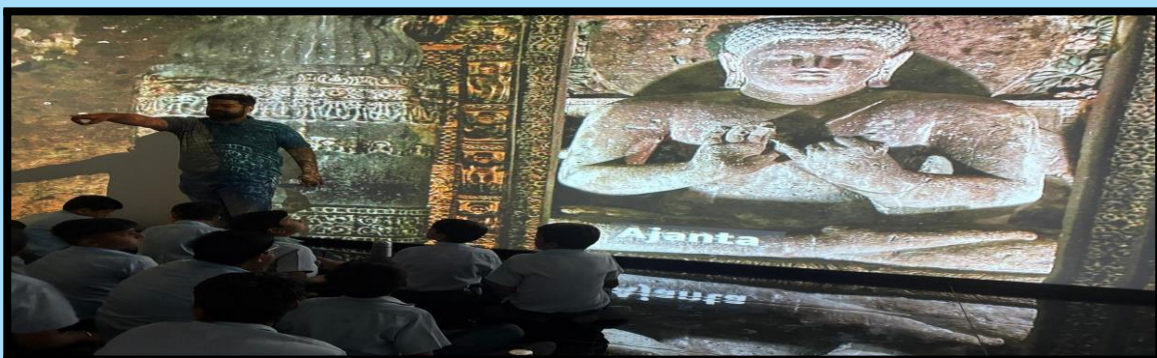
They learned about the life, vision, and achievements of each Prime Minister of India—from Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru to the present
