

NCC CAMP REPORT
COMBINED ANNUAL TRAINING CAMP -1
(15 MAY 2023 – 24 MAY 2023)

The escorting teacher was ANO of the school - 1st officer Dr Rita Yadav.

535 cadets (JW & SW) from 13 schools and 9 colleges, 1 Commanding Officer, 5 ANOs, 4 caretakers, 3 GCIs, 14 PI Staff and 6 Civil staff of NCC participated in this camp.

The Annual Training Camp aimed to promote the spirit of adventure, develop National Integration and familiarize cadets with the value of unity and discipline.

A firing was also set up where all the cadets were able to showcase their shooting skills using five real bullets with a .22 rifle. All the cadets performed excellently. The cadets also got an opportunity to visit the National War Memorial on 22nd May 2023 and they were instilled with a feeling of patriotism in them.
