

# **ACTIVITY: FUN WITH NUMBERS**

**CLASS: PRE-SCHOOL**

**DATE: 10.11.2025**

## **ACTIVITY DESCRIPTION-**

A “Fun with Numbers” activity was organized for the preschoolers to explore basic numeracy through hands-on activities. Students did three simple tasks:

1. They counted beads on an abacus and placed a number card next to the beads.
2. They put a glass on the matching number that was written on the glass.
3. They stacked blocks according to the number shown on a card.

The lively, tactile approach kept the students engaged while reinforcing number recognition and sequencing.

## **LEARNING OUTCOMES-**

1. Recognized and identified numbers.
2. Developed counting skills using an abacus.
3. Practiced fine motor coordination by placing cards, glasses, and blocks.
4. Strengthened visual-spatial understanding through matching numbers to quantities.
5. Encouraged cooperative play and verbal communication about numbers.
